EVALUATION OF THE CREATING HOME PROGRAM

Evaluation of a capacity building program equipping disability accommodation providers to design and offer individualised living arrangements. The evaluation included extensive consultation with participating organisations, observation research, and desktop analysis.

As a result of this program more people with disability have been supported to create individualised living arrangements that work for them.
